Welcome!

It has been a pleasure to get to know the children and experience polite manners, great attitudes to learning which we will continue to maintain and grow. Too support the children with this, we have introduced new rewards systems to support and celebrate good behaviour, achievements and learning. These are:

Star of the week

Every week the school comes together to celebrate children's learning and achievements. Part of the celebration assembly is the 'star of the week' award. One child from each class will be awarded this certificate for going above and beyond what is expected. This could include supporting others in class or lunchtime or showing resilience with their work.

House Points

We are going to expand on bringing the children together in their houses. The children will be rewarded house points for lots of different aspects of school life. These will include, good manners, supporting others, resilience etc. The house points will be tallied up for individual and house rewards. These will be shared in our celebration assembly.

<u>Always club</u>

This club is open to children who are noticed for 'always' doing the right thing. They will be rewarded with special activities, maybe even a trip out!

<u>Uniform</u>

When children look smart, they feel smart and we notice that this then has a positive impact on the children's behavior and attitudes in school. School uniform promotes the feeling of belonging, equality and sense of community. Thank you for your ongoing support with ensuring your child comes to school in the correct uniform for both school and PE days.

Swimming

Oak and Chestnut children spent their afternoons swimming at Dawlish Leisure Centre last week. The children were learning vital water skills, which are especially important as we live by the coast. The children made the school proud with their polite manners and good behaviour. The children themselves have commented on how they feel more confident in the water and are able to do new things.
