Contacting School

In addition, we are using a new emailing system, so please add this address to your contacts. Some parents have made us aware that they are not receiving emails from us in their inboxes, so please check your spam / junk box. Adding our new email address to your contacts should resolve this issue.

You are able to use Seesaw to get direct messages to your class teacher as well.

Homework

The children will have brought home their first piece of homework in their new homework books last week. Thank you to everyone who filled in our homework survey. The majority of parents preferred weekly homework in a book, so this is what we have decided to go with this term.

Homework will be set on a Friday and the books will need to be returned with homework completed by Wednesday of the following week. There will be a homework club on a Wednesday lunchtime for anyone who may not have had time to complete this at home.

The teachers will mark the children's homework with either a tick or a stamp. Children can earn house points for completing their homework as well, and these will be given at the discretion of their teacher.

The tasks sent home will vary between maths and literacy each week. There may also be other subjects, e.g. geography or history. The children will also need to read daily. Please record in your child's reading diary when they have read at home with you.

Class Curriculum Letter and Maps

The teachers have been busy writing curriculum letters and maps to share with you, so you can see what the children will be learning at school. These will be posted to the class pages and shared via messages on Seesaw as well. Please see your class teacher if you have any questions or any expertise in these areas, where you may be able to help enhance the children's learning.

Seesaw

We are running Seesaw across the whole school again this term. We are changing the way we are logging into Seesaw. You will have received a link via email which you will need to use to log into the Seesaw Family App. This will enable you to see all your children at once, rather than having to log in and out of each child's journal with a QR code. If you are having any problems with setting up Seesaw, please let Mrs Sandercock know.

Attendance

What a fantastic first couple of weeks we have had. It's been lovely to see children arriving at school on time and being ready for learning at 9am. Just a reminder that the gates close at 8.55am now, so children are in class, ready for their learning to begin, at 9am. If you arrive after the gate has closed, please go through the main door. Any children arriving at 9am or later will need to be signed in.

Our celebration assembly is about celebrating various aspects of school, and this week we are going to be awarding a certificate for the class with the best attendance.

Just a reminder to be aware that I am unable to authorise any holiday requests during term time. Every day is important to the children's learning and attendance at school is essential as the children have missed so much schooling due to the pandemic. We must work together to ensure the children's attendance is the best it can be and we are aiming to be at 96 % by the end of the term.

Playtimes

We are currently developing resources for the children to use at playtime to support friendships and behaviour. The children currently have pens, books, colouring, wooden blocks and some other play equipment. If anyone has any outside play equipment they are no longer using and are willing to donate to school, please speak to Mrs Sandercock.

Willow Class


In Willow Class our topic this half-term is called 'Wonderful me!'.
