The club is open every morning during school term time. We offer a safe, caring and friendly environment for our children.

Breakfast selection available

The children will be able to select from a variety of cereals with milk, toast with margarine and toppings, fruit, fruit juice and water.

Admission procedures and bookings

If you wish your child to attend the club you will need to complete a registration form, available from the office or Breakfast Club staff. This gives us all the necessary information, such as medical information, contact numbers and addresses. The registration acts as a commitment to the sessions booked for a half-term. If a reduction in days booked needs to be made, please ensure that a week's notice is given. You and your child are welcome to make a preliminary visit to the club if you wish. Please contact the Play Workers or the school office to make arrangements for this.

Medicines

If your child needs to take any medicines while at the club, please complete the appropriate form, available from the Play Workers

Fees and billing

Current fees for the Breakfast Club are £3.50 per child per session. You will need to book your child's/ children's places at Breakfast Club using the SchoolMoney system. Payments need to be made at the time of booking.

We do not make reductions for later delivery of children.

Age range of eligible children

Children of Kenton Primary School, aged from 3 to 11 years, are welcome to come to the Breakfast Club.

Cancellation/ sickness

At present we are unable to offer refunds for cancelled places or sickness. If your child is not attending the club for any reason Breakfast Club staff will need to be informed as soon as possible. In the case of sickness this may need to be on the morning of the session on the school telephone number – 01626 890465.

Policies and practices

The school policies and procedures also apply to our breakfast Club. Please find these on the school website.

Possible concerns

Do I have to bring my child at 7.45AM?

You can bring your child to Breakfast Club at any time between 7.45 and 8.45 am.

How long will breakfast be served for?

Breakfast will be served until 8.30am, to allow children to finish eating before going in to class.

Can I bring my child to Breakfast Club without notice? Unfortunately we are unable to accept children at the Breakfast Club without notice.

Are you able to cater for specific dietary needs?

We will discuss all dietary needs with parents and will endeavour to cater to meet these.
