


Autumn Two in Oak

English

We are going to read *Great Women who changed the world* by Kate Pankhurst. We are going to write a biography about someone who is in our life.

We will continue to develop the children's reading skills through targeted sessions focussing on retrieval, inference, vocabulary and prediction.

We are reading...



Maths

We are looking at addition and subtraction and learning column addition and subtraction methods. Then we are moving onto multiplication and subtraction. This will involve linking time tables knowledge to solving multiplication and division calculations and solving problems within a context.

Science

In science we will learn about sound. We will learn how sounds are produced and we will investigate patterns in pitch, volume, shape of objects, strengths of vibrations and distance.

Our key investigation will be using data loggers to measure decibels. We will also be making earmuffs from a variety of materials to investigate which provides the best insulation against sound.

DT

We will be focusing on cooking and nutrition. We will be designing a meal to sustain an explorer. Children will learn about food groups and flavours when planning their meal; they will need to ensure that their meal is balanced and healthy and will be developing their cutting skills.

French

We will be learning all about animals in French. The children will recap the vocabulary they have learnt so far this and use this alongside the French words for animal names.



Geography

Where would I like to go?

We will be using maps, atlases and globes to locate different countries of interest and we will describe the human and physical features. We will look at countries, cities and how natural features shape the borders of different countries.

We will compare a region of the United Kingdom, a region in a European country and a region within North or South America.

RE

The Key question is 'How do festivals and worship show what matters to a Muslim?'

Children will recap prior learning about Islam and will explore Muslim festivals including Eid and Ramadan. They will consider why traditions are continued within these festivals and what this means to Muslims. We will celebrate the children's learning by holding an Eid celebration.

Music

This unit of music is all about enjoying improvisation. The children will use glockenspiels to play and compose music.

The children will also be learning Christmas Carols ready for our service in December.

PSHE

PSHE will be learning about 'Valuing difference.' Within this, we will be exploring respecting each other and discuss our similarities and differences. We will talk about things that make us unique and celebrate these.

Computing

In computing we will be learning about the internet.

We will be recognising the internet as a network of networks including the WWW and why we should evaluate online content.

PE

In PE Year 3 and 4 will be learning the skills and tactics of Netball. They will be working on their throwing and catching skills and learning how to attack and defend. They will also be working on Dance with Mrs Murray.
