

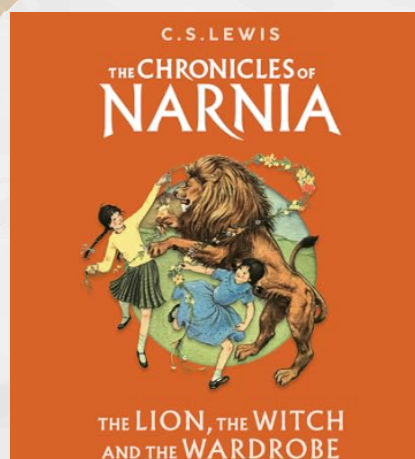
Spring One in Oak

English

We are going to be reading 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' by C.S. Lewis. We will be writing an alternative version of the story.

We are reading...



Maths

We are looking at multiplication and division, length and perimeter and area.

Please practise your times tables at home. Ask children questions such as what is 3 lots of 4? What is 5 multiplied by 9? What is 30 divided by 5? What is 42 shared by 6?

Science

In science we will learn about states and matter. We will learn about solids, liquids and gases- what they are and why they occur. We will learn about the changes of state and evaporation and condensation in the water cycle.

As our investigation for this half term, we will observe water as a solid, liquid and a gas and note changes when water is heated or cooled.

Art

We will be working with shape and colour. We will be using collage and stencils in response to looking at art work.

French

We will be learning 10 familiar activities that they are able to not able to do in French.



History

How did life change from the Stone Age to the Iron Age?

We will continue our Autumn 1 topic of the Stone Age and move on to learn about the Bronze Age and Iron Age. We will learn what life was like and compare the different

We will be going on a trip to the Royal Albert Memorial Museum and Art Gallery on the 17th January to look at the artefacts they have.

RE

The Key question is 'What is it like to follow God?'

The children will be introduced to the Bible- Old Testament and the New Testament. They will be looking at the story of Noah from Genesis 6:5-9:17. They will make links between the promises in the story of Noah and the promises that Christians make at a wedding ceremony. They will also make connections of how we live at school and in the wider world.

Music

This unit will be all about composing music using our imagination. We will be using our voices and glockenspiels.

We will also begin rehearsals for our Ivy Education Music Trust event. We will be working with music professionals to create our own song!

PSHE

PSHE will be learning about 'Keeping myself safe.' We will discuss what is safe and unsafe and what is a danger and risk. We will also discuss medicines, alcohol and cigarettes.

Computing

In computing we will be learning about stop- frame animation. Children will become confident taking pictures on an ipad and will sequence these to make a story.

We will be capturing and editing digital still images to produce a stop- frame animation that tells a story. They will use and add other types of media to their animation, such as music and text.

PE

In PE Year 3 and 4 will be learning the skills of Gymnastics. We will work on our core balance, learn a series of balances and will create sequences of movements.
